Is it?

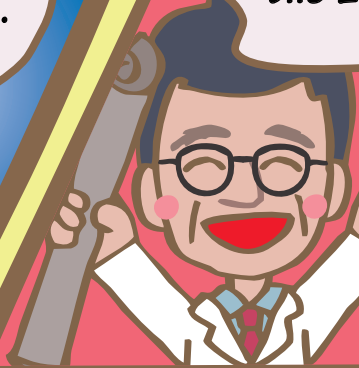
I used to diagnose and cure suffering communities and countries, like a doctor would.

And then I started to diagnose the Earth as a whole instead of individual countries.

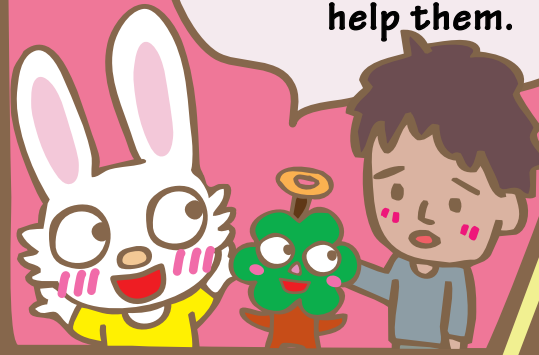
Wow!

of the Earth too.



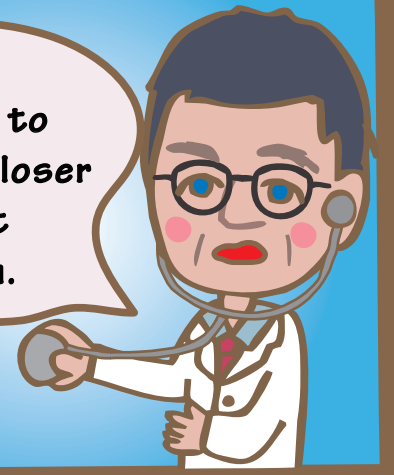
That's good to hear,

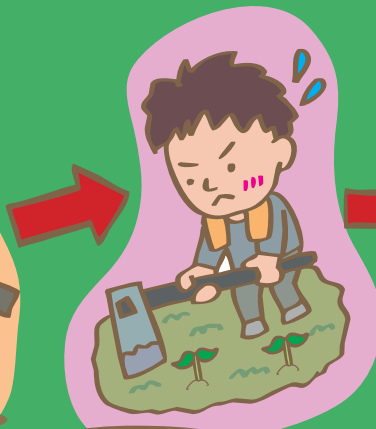

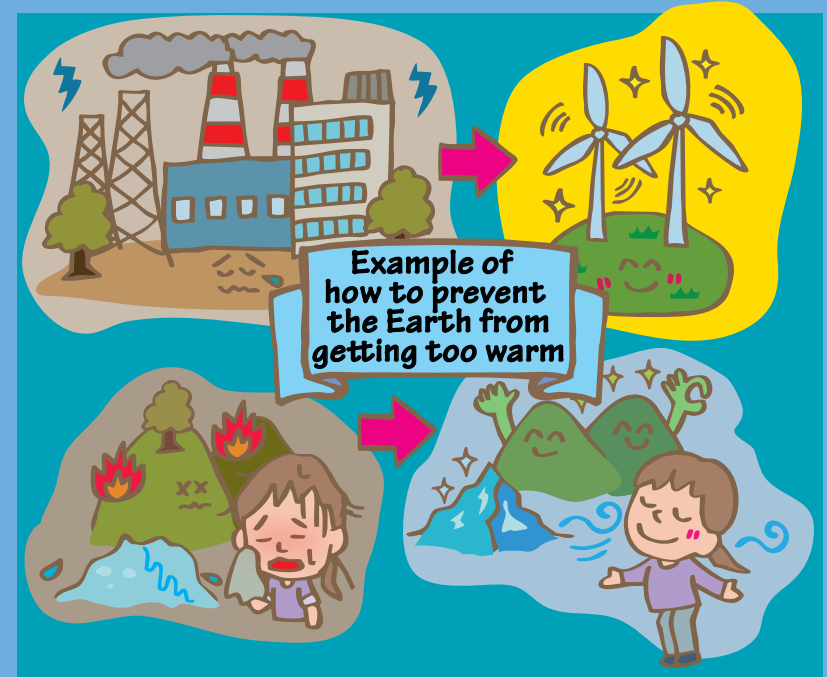
Example of how to help people get out of poverty



Most importantly, we must help them to get started.



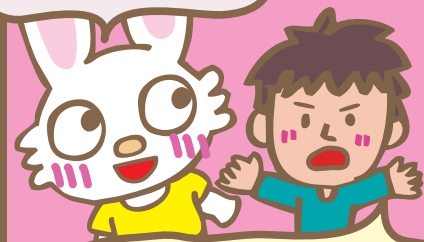
13 CLIMATE ACTION

There are still many more friends who are suffering.

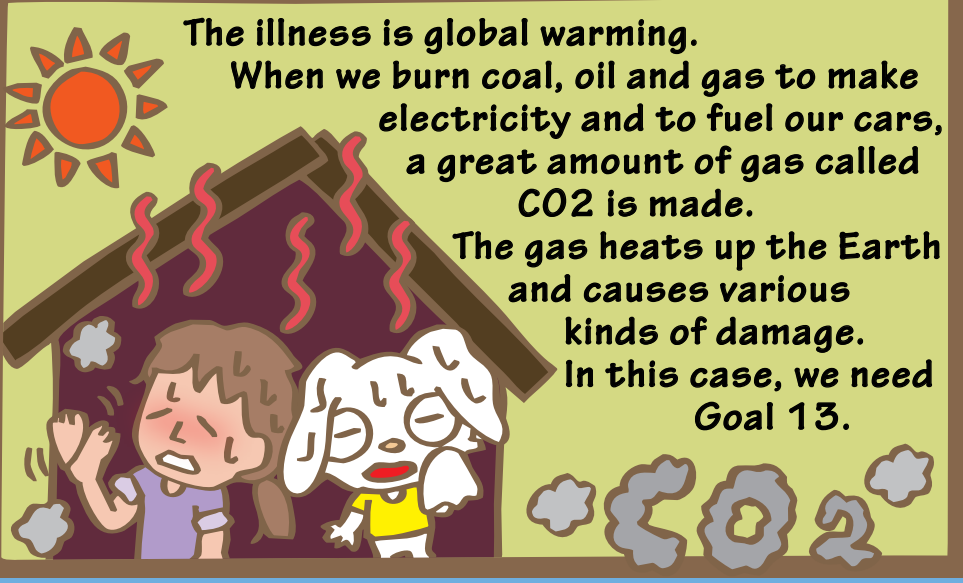
Our mission is to keep the Earth healthy and happy long into the future, with no one left behind.

What about the other friends?

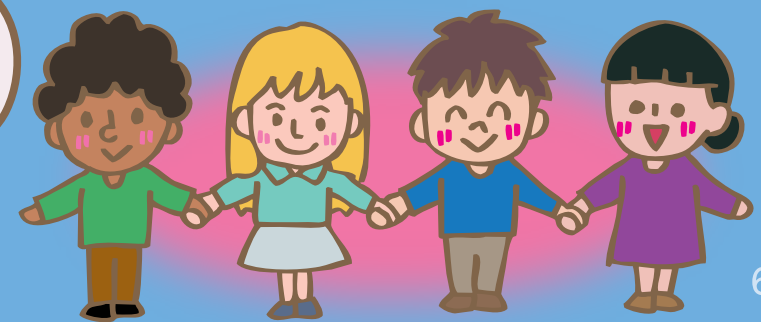
