in trouble.

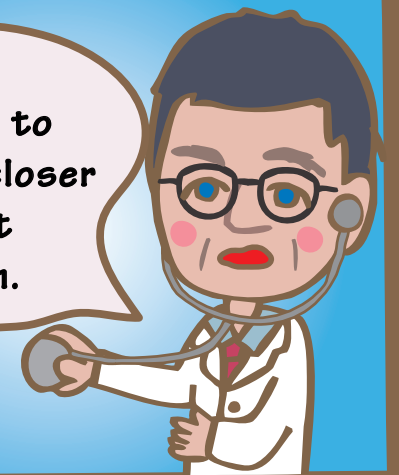
I know.

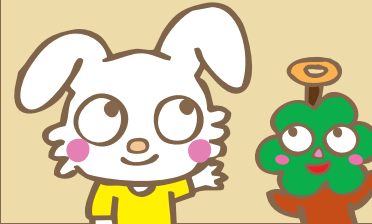

better!



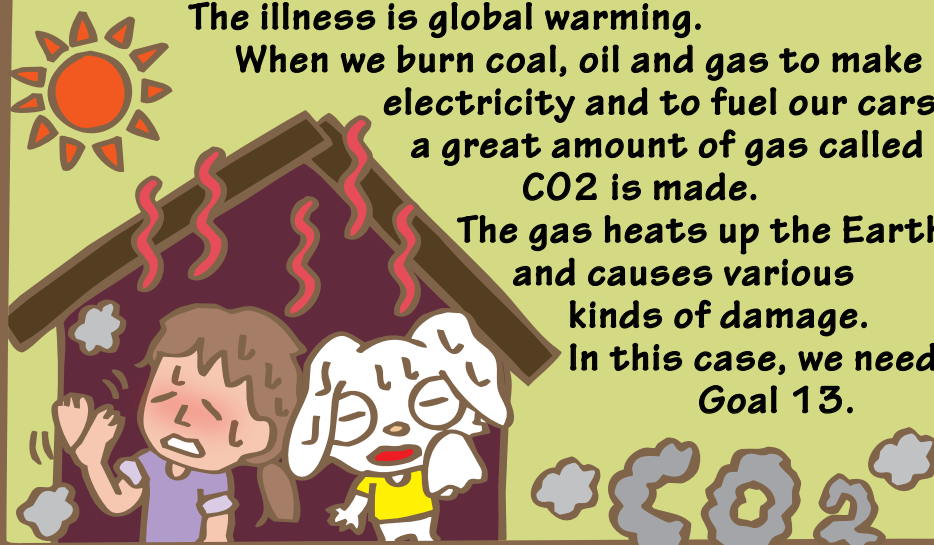
There are still many

Sounds great!

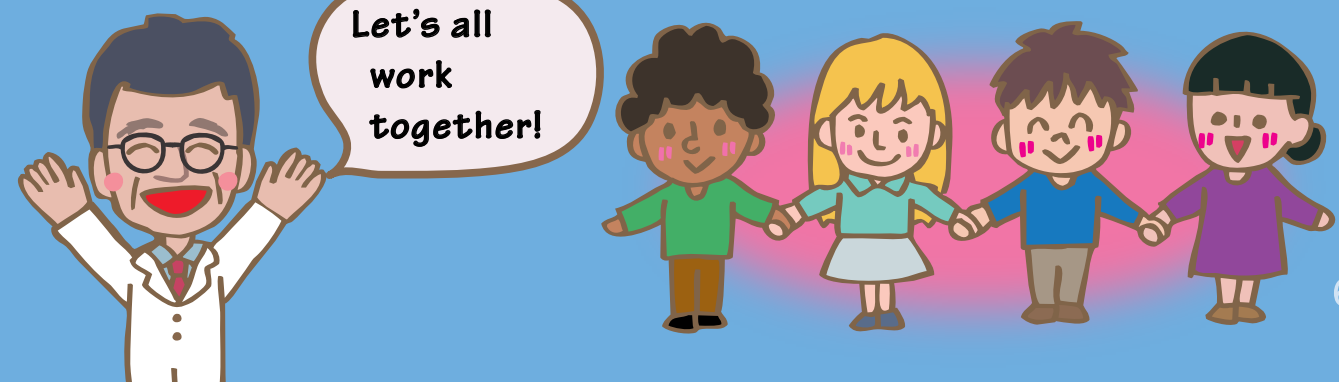


The illness is global warming.
